



# Rockingham Raceway

## 1/24<sup>th</sup> Scale RETRO SALOON CAR CHAMPIONSHIP

The following cars will be eligible for the Championship

Any Car built to current UKRRA Saloon Car rules

Race control may also permit cars built to the following rules to race but they will not be eligible for the Club Championship:

*Rockingham 1/24<sup>th</sup> Production Cars fitted with a Classic Saloon style body.*

## Summary of the basic UKRRA Saloon Car rules

### 1. Chassis

- a. Any scratch built or kit built, inline, 'Brass and Wire' chassis that complies with the UKRRA Saloon Car Rules.

### 2. Motor

- a. Only the following motors are permitted:  
JK Falcon 7, TSR (D3) Falcon, JK Hawk 7, Trinity Evil 9, Fast Ones Demon and Slick 7 S7-588 Mini Motor.

### 3. Body

- a. Any vac' formed (Lexan, PETG etc) 1/24<sup>th</sup> scale replica of a real, 4 plus seat, Saloon/Sedan/Touring Car built and raced before the end of 1972 can be used.
- b. Bodies must be fully painted, detailed and numbered in accordance with UKRRA guidelines.
- c. Bodies must cover the entire chassis, including the guide, the motor and the wheels, tyres and gears when viewed from directly above.
- d. Wheel arch openings must be cut out as on the real car.
- e. A detailed interior, including a driver, must be fitted and no part of the chassis or running gear may be visible through the windscreen or windows.

### 4. Dimensions

- a. Bodies must not be trimmed above the lower door line.
- b. Add on spoilers and trim tabs are not permitted.
- c. Overall Width of the entire car must not exceed 82.55mm.
- d. Overall chassis width, including wheels and tyres must not exceed 76.02mm.
- e. Minimum Ground Clearance: Front – 0.38mm. Rear – 1.27mm.
- f. Wheels and Tyres.  
Rear: Maximum width – 20.57mm. Minimum diameter – 19.05mm.  
Front: Minimum Width – 9.53mm. Minimum diameter – 19.05mm.
